Family Bible Study - Week 34
Hebrews 10:36-39

Read the text in the NKJV. Suggested memory verses: 10:36-37. In lieu of *memorizing* the verses, read the assigned text every single day for a week.

FOR ADULTS:

The main idea is: “We are those who believe to the saving of the soul.”

The theme for Hebrews is seen clearly in verse 36. What is that theme?

What passage is the writer quoting in verse 37?

What passage is the writer quoting in verse 38?

How does God feel about a Christian who does not stay faithful?

What does faith have to do with having our souls saved? Are we saved by faith alone?

What are some examples of *not* living by faith?

FOR TEENS:

The theme for Hebrews is seen clearly in verse 36. What is that theme?

What is the “promise” the writer has in mind?

Give another passage where Habakkuk 2:4 is quoted:

What event is the writer anticipating in verse 37 (compare the verse with the quotation from Isa. 26:20)?

In your words, what does the writer mean by “living by faith?”

What does it mean for someone to “draw back” (cf. 3:19)?

How would you define “perdition?”

Give some examples you anticipate this week that will require you to “live by faith:”

FOR KIDS:

What does “endurance” mean?

Give some other areas of life which require endurance:

What does it mean to you that Jesus is coming back?

FOR PRE-SCHOOL:

What are some areas in your life that require “endurance?”

Why is it important to keep our faith in Jesus until He comes back?

How does faith help us endure?

Draw a picture of Jesus returning from heaven:
